What Is Energy Assistance?

Energy Assistance is a federally funded program for qualified households, which provides a one-time benefit (per program year) to assist with heating costs. The program year runs from November 2007 through March 2008.

How Do I Qualify?

Eligibility for Energy Assistance is based on a number of factors including household size and income as outlined in the chart.

Important Note

Applications aren't mailed automatically each year. You must contact your local Community Action Partnership Agency (see list on back) to receive an application and qualify for assistance.
