## ***What Is Energy Assistance?***

Energy Assistance is a federally funded program for qualified households, which provides a one-time benefit (per program year) to assist with heating costs. The program year runs from November 2008 through March 2009.

## ***How Do I Qualify?***

Eligibility for Energy Assistance is based on a number of factors including household size and income as outlined in the chart.

## ***Important Note***

Applications are not mailed automatically each year. You must contact your local Community Action Partnership Agency (see list on back) to receive an appointment time and qualify for assistance.
