



Keep cool, save money



Sign up now for Idaho Power's **A/C Cool Credit** program and save \$7 each month on your July, August and September electric bills. On select summer afternoons, your air conditioner will cycle on and off, reducing electrical demand during periods when usage often peaks. Thousands of Idaho and Oregon residents have already joined, and nearly 98 percent of participants noticed little or no difference in household temperature.

What's involved?

1. Sign up online, via the toll-free number below or by returning this form with your Idaho Power bill payment.
2. A small "Cool Switch" will be installed outside near your A/C unit.
3. On occasional summer afternoons, the Cool Switch will cycle your A/C unit about 50 percent of the time (ex: 15 minutes on, 15 minutes off). You'll automatically receive the credit on your bill.

When you sign up, a "Cool Switch" device is installed near your central air conditioning (A/C) unit. When system demands reach their peak, the switch cycles your A/C off for a short period each half hour — usually between 4 and 7 p.m. — while still keeping you comfortable. Most participants notice little or no difference in temperature. Installation is free and takes about 10 minutes. You don't even have to be home if your A/C is easily accessible.
