Idaho Power's Weatherization Assistance program funds the installation of cost-effective weatherization measures to the homes of qualified customers.

Idaho Power provides financial assistance to Idaho and Oregon Community Action Partnership (CAP) agencies to help cover the cost for weatherization of electrically heated homes of qualified customers. These enhancements enable residents to maintain a comfortable and energy efficient home environment.

Some program benefits:

- Weatherization improvements are available at no cost to qualifying applicants who own or rent their homes.
- Weatherization improvements help reduce energy costs for qualified customers by increasing the efficiency of their home while providing health and safety measures.
- Improvements like insulation, weather stripping, and sealing air leaks make a home, apartment or manufactured home more comfortable.
- Consumers receive efficiency ideas for saving energy in their homes.
- Weatherization improvements benefit families, communities and the environment.
