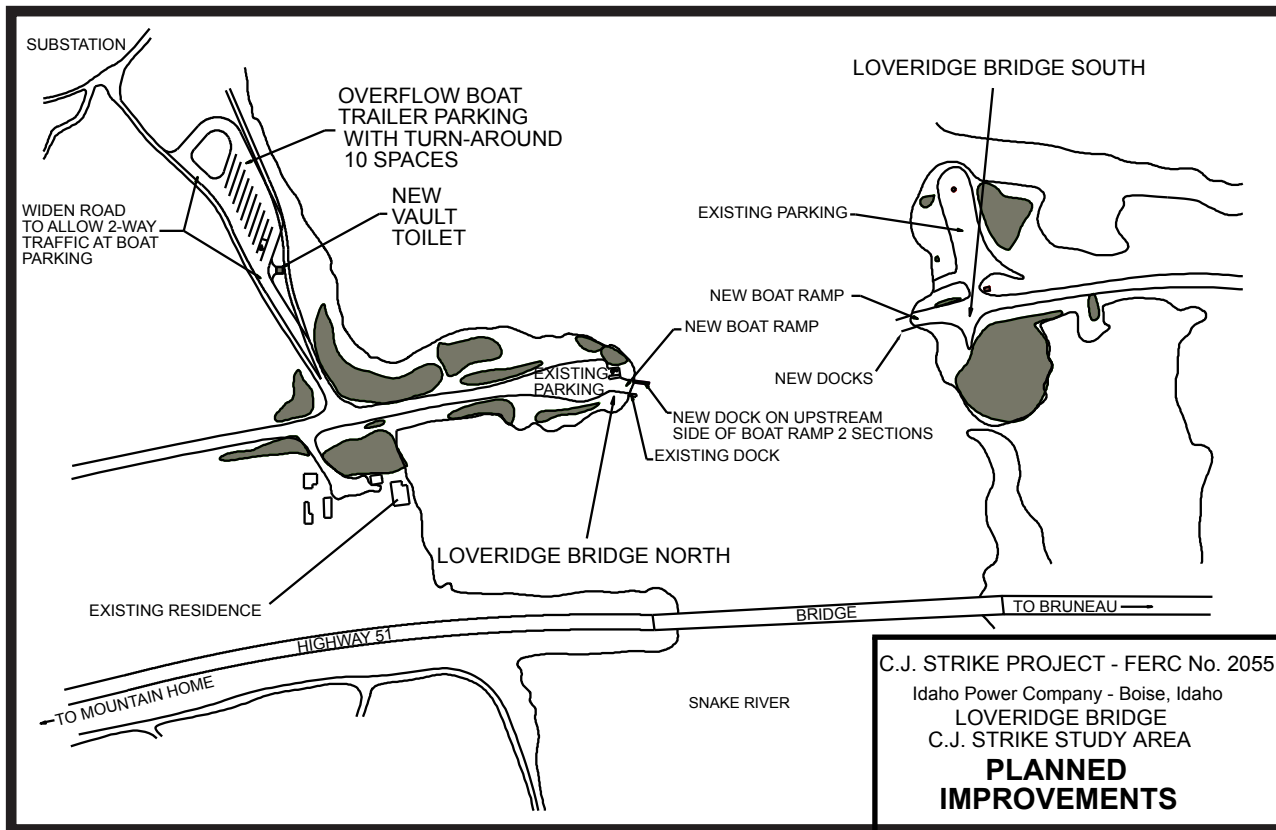


What is Happening at Loveridge Bridge?

The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC), issued Idaho Power a new 30-year operational license for the C. J. Strike Hydroelectric Project on August 4, 2004. The license includes a number of fish, wildlife, aquatic, archaeological, and botanical enhancements as well as recreational facility enhancements and interpretational signage. The site drawing below illustrates planned enhancements for Loveridge Bridge.



- **Loveridge Bridge will remain open to the public, with some restrictions, during construction in 2008 through early 2009.**

- Some site features will change slightly during the permitting and construction process.

- Loveridge Bridge will feature:
New Two-Lane Boat Ramps (North and South)
New Boarding Piers
Expanded Boat Trailer Parking (North and South)
Vault Toilet (North Side)
