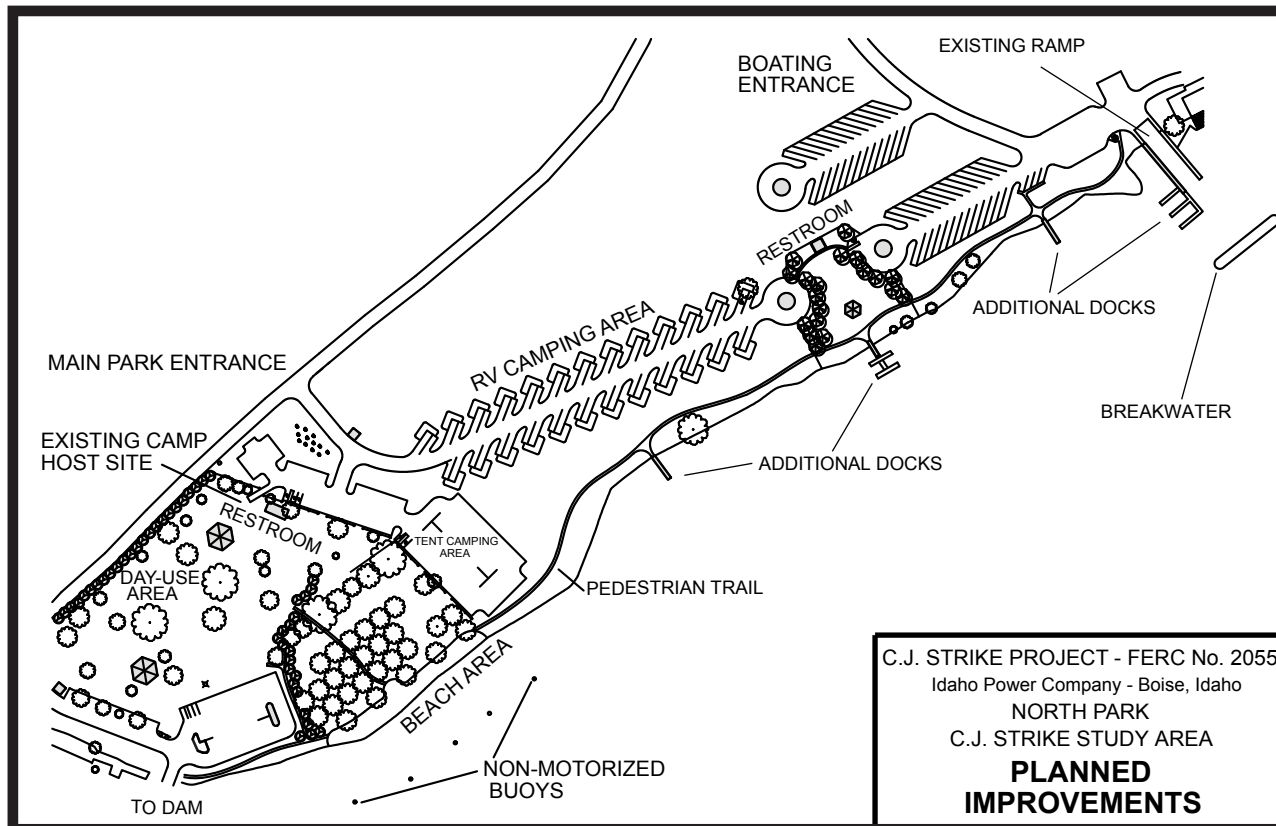


What is Happening at North Park?

The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC), issued Idaho Power a new 30-year operational license for the C. J. Strike Hydroelectric Project on August 4, 2004. The license includes a number of fish, wildlife, aquatic, archaeological, and botanical enhancements as well as recreational facility enhancements and interpretational signage. The site drawing below illustrates planned enhancements for North Park.



- North Park will remain open to the public, with some restrictions, during construction in 2008 through early 2009.

- Some site features will change slightly during the permitting and construction process.

- North Park will feature:

- 20 - 25 Campsites
- Group Shelters and Day Use Area
- Breakwater
- New Fish Cleaning Station
- Additional Restrooms
- Tree Plantings and Irrigation
- Designated Tent Camping
- New Mooring & Boarding Structures
- Beach Area
- Day Use Parking
- Waterfront Walking Path
