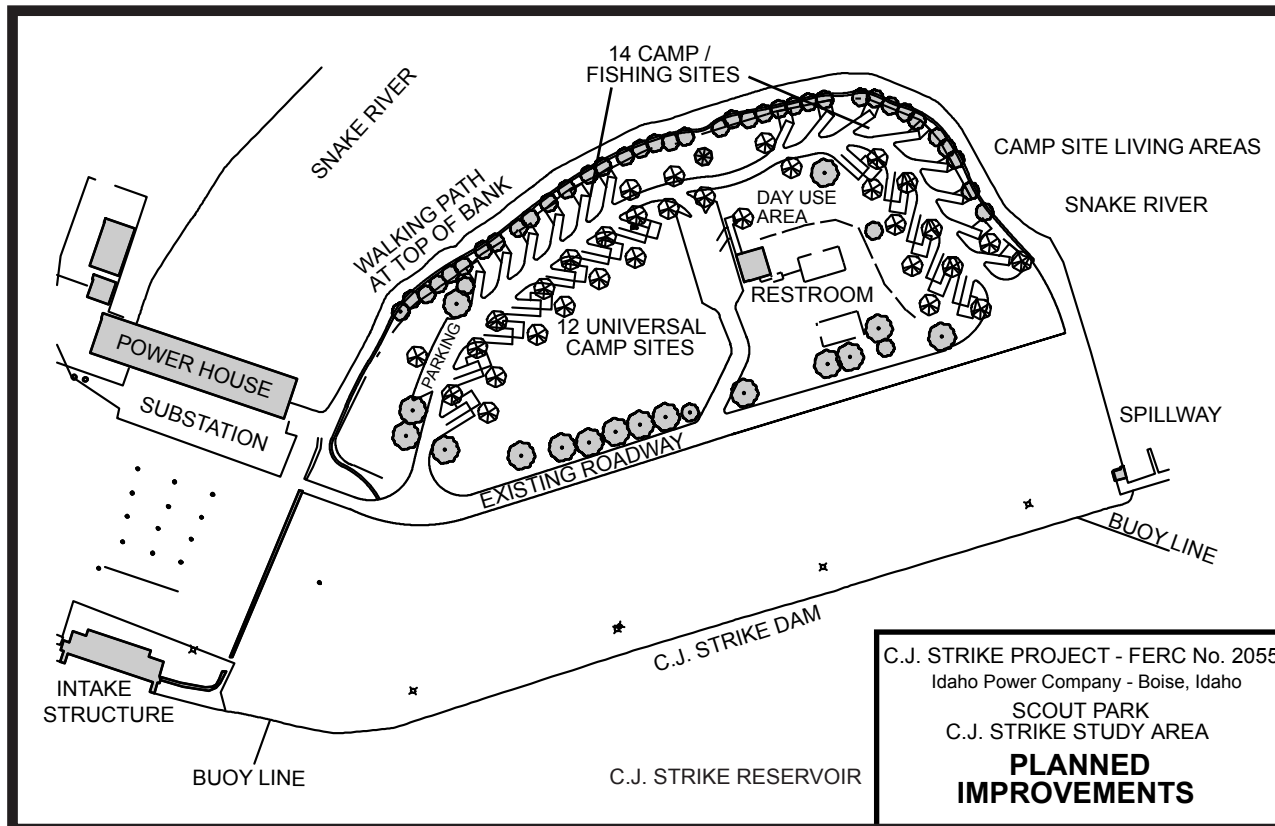


## What is Happening at Scout Park?

The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC), issued Idaho Power a new 30-year operational license for the C. J. Strike Hydroelectric Project on August 4, 2004. The license includes a number of fish, wildlife, aquatic, archaeological, and botanical enhancements as well as recreational facility enhancements and interpretational signage. The site drawing below illustrates planned enhancements for Scout Park.



- Scout Park will remain open to the public, with some restrictions, during construction in 2008 through early 2009.

- Some site features will change slightly during the permitting and construction process.

- Scout Park will feature:

- 10 - 14 Camping / Fishing Sites
- 10 - 14 Universal Campsites
- New Group Picnic Shelter
- Waterfront Walking Path
- Day-Use Parking Area
- Tree Plantings
- Picnic Tables
